Age: The upper age-limit for appointment as a Senior Resident in broad specialties shall be **forty-five years**: Provided that for the subjects of Anatomy, Biochemistry, Physiology, Pharmacology, Microbiology, Pathology, Forensic Medicine and Community Medicine, the upper age-limit shall be **fifty years**.

Senior Resident: Any person undergoing residency in a relevant department of a recognised medical institution after obtaining the following qualification, namely:

(a) Postgraduate degree in **Doctor of Medicine** or **Master of Surgery** or **Diplomate of National Board**; or

(b) Postgraduate medical degree in Master of Science with Doctor of Philosophy in the medical subjects of Anatomy or Biochemistry or Physiology or Pharmacology or Microbiology, shall be eligible for appointment as a Senior Resident.

Annexure "B"General Terms and Conditions for Senior ResidentTerms of Contract:

1. **Senior Resident** – The tenure of 3 years for Senior Residents is subject to satisfactory performance evaluation on annual basis. No extension beyond 3 years of the tenure.
2. **Candidates who have worked already as a Senior Resident under 3 years Central Residency Scheme for 3 years are not eligible for applying for the post of Senior Resident.**
3. **Senior Resident who are already working in any Govt. institution/ Hospital shall apply along with NOC.**
4. **Remuneration:** - Initial Pay in **Level -11** with basic pay of **Rs. 67,700/-** plus other allowances as applicable under 7th CPC. Private practice of any kind will not be allowed.

Total Gross Emoluments drawn by a Senior Resident (3 years) for the month of Jan.2026 is Rs. 1,60,045/- (approximately) and this remuneration will be revised whenever there is revision of rates of DA as per ESIC Hqrs. Office which is line with the Central Government Employees.

5. **Senior Resident (3 years tenure) will be eligible for kinds of leave as admissible to temporary government employees in accordance with the provisions of CCS (Leave) Rules 1972.**
6. Rules for Reservation will be implemented as per Govt. of India instructions.
7. The engagement shall not confer any right or preference for regular appointment.
8. No claim for any service benefits like PF, Pension, Medical allowances, Medical benefits, Seniority, Promotion etc. will be admissible.
